Dear Vermont Veterinary Student,

Our Foundation welcomes your application for one of our scholarship awards.

We recognize that the time available to you for filling out applications is limited, so please be advised of the following about our scholarships:

This is the seventh year our foundation has been in existence. The amount of our scholarship awards will depend on the number of applicants and their needs. We recognize the debt load carried by veterinary school graduates is often very high, and it would be our intent to make fewer, and larger, awards. We would like to make a real difference in the debt of the most promising graduates.

Students entering their final years of school will be given preference for awards as their debt burden is the highest. However, other students are encouraged to apply. The Foundation will consider all career tracks including both small and large animal applicants. All applicants **must** have completed their first year of veterinary school.

We realize that (usually for reasons of in-state tuition) applicants may not currently retain Vermont as their legal address. However, we do expect that applicants have resided in Vermont for most of their years, and intend to return to Vermont to practice.

Scholastic achievement is important, but so is your determination and ability to surmount obstacles, including financial difficulties, personal struggles, disabilities, etc., which confront entrants into the veterinary profession. We are looking to reward uniquely talented, motivated students with the will to succeed no matter what situation they are in.
